How much does the HCCC curriculum cost?

- The HCCC is free once the instructor completes the HCCC Educate the Educator Course for \$140.00.

What if our school district cannot find a qualified Instructor for the Lab/Clinical in the Pathway to the Nursing Assistant-Registry?

- Outsource by contracting with your local college or nursing home in your area for a qualified instructor.

As an academic teacher how can I get the medical experience required by the Minnesota Department of Health (MDH) to be a trainer to teach the HCCC as a pathway to the Nursing Assistant –Registry (NA-R)?

- One creative idea might become a NA-R and work part time for a year to meet the MDH requirements.
